Adyghe State University will be hosting the **4th International Academic Conference "Autumn Mathematical Readings in Adygea"** dedicated to the 80th anniversary of the Mathematics and Computer Sciences Department. The conference is scheduled from October 12 to 17, 2021 in Maykop (Republic of Adygea, Russia). The conference will include paper presentation and lectures for undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students. All abstracts will be peer reviewed. By the start of the conference the selected papers will be published in the conference proceedings indexed with ISBN and RSCI.

The deadline for abstract submission is **August 10, 2021**.

Paper presentation is not obligatory for participation.

The conference will be held online and offline due to the current epidemiological situation in the Republic of Adygea and Russia as a whole. The offline part of the conference is supposed to take place at Adyghe State University in Maykop. Those willing to participate in the offline part of the conference must have a certificate of negative COVID-19 test result (the test must be taken no earlier than three days before arrival at the conference).
